A different kind of schooling show! Dressage, Hunt seat Equitation and Jumping, Horsemanship skills and knowledge! Grand and Reserve in 4 age groups; 11 and under, 12 to 14, 15 to 17, 18 and over. Preference for Championships given to riders who enter the most divisions, must do at least 4 classes. Pre-registration preferred. 2015 Negative coggins required, bring copy. Concessions on grounds. No refunds.

Division #1: Dressage. May enter **Two** classes. Riders are allowed. Arena 20 meters by 40 meters. Points count only from the class where the rider places higher.

Class 1A: USDF Intro Level Test A

Class 1B: USDF Intro Level Test B

Class 1C: USDF Training Level Test 1

Class 1D: USDF Training Level Test 2

Division #2: Hunter over fences. May enter **Two** classes. Points count only from class which corresponds to the equitation class that is entered.

Class 2A: trot over a marked course of ground poles. May post or do 2-point over the poles.

Class 2B: teeny tiny X's; trot or controlled canter.

Class 2C: minuscule hunter; small verticals, flower boxes, up to 1'6".

Class 2D: low hunter, fences up to 2'.

Division #3: Equitation over fences. Same as above, judged on Equitation. May enter only **ONE**.

Class 3A 3B 3C 3D

Division #4: Equitation on the flat. May enter only **ONE**.

Class 4A: Walk/trot, for beginning riders only.

Class 4B: Walk/trot for beginning horse or rider. Judge may also ask for the sitting trot.

Class 4C: W/T/C, intermediate rider. Judge may ask for sitting trot and/or 2-point at the trot.

Class 4D: W/T/C, more advanced rider. Sitting trot, 2-point at trot or canter may be asked for.

Division #5: Equine IQ. Bring your tacked up mount to the judge for a verbal test of your knowledge. Enter only **ONE**.

Class 5A: beginner; answer simple questions about parts of the horse and your tack.

Class 5B: intermediate; answer questions about parts of the horse, tack and grooming.

Class 5C: advanced; answer questions about parts of the horse, tack, grooming and horse health.

Division #6: Fun Classes \$4.00 each, can sign up day of show. May add more classes before show date!

Class 6A: Tandem Hunter, 1'6" double entry. Call for details.

Class 6B: Trail Obstacles, test your skills while riding a pattern through these simple obstacles.

Class 6C: Judge's Command

Class 6D: Walk/Trot bareback Equitation **and** Walk/Trot/Canter bareback Equitation. Specify which on entry.

Class 6E: Bribe a Horse
